

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all counsel and witnesses shall abstain from any reference, comment or evidence, either by way of documents or testimony, as to any correspondence between Owens-Illinois and the Saranac Laboratory of Saranac Lake, and various reports prepared by said Laboratory, relating to animal studies using the product called "Kaylo" (hereafter "Saranac Lake Documents") without first obtaining permission of the trial court out of the presence or hearing of the jury. All counsel are ordered to inform all witnesses to comply with this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Saranac Lake Documents are inadmissible against Owens-Corning Fiberglass Corporation. The admissibility of said documents as against Owens-Corning Fiberglass Corporation has been submitted to this Court upon the depositions of Edward Ames, Walter Hazard and Richard R. Beck conducted on March 26, 1981, March 27, 1981 and April 1, 1981,

1 respectively, in the St. Jacque case, including all exhibits.  
2 This Court determines that said evidence fails to present suffi-  
3 cient evidence to sustain a finding that Owens-Corning Fiberglass  
4 Corporation had actual knowledge of said documents.
