FOURTH AMENDED
GENERAL ORDER NO. 3

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the County Clerk shall continue to maintain two special files designated as follows: (1) In re Los Angeles Asbestos Litigation - General Orders, File No. C 700000 (hereinafter "General Order File") and (2) In re Los Angeles Asbestos Litigation - Motions Re General Orders, File No. C 700002 (hereinafter "General Order Motion File"). Said files shall be maintained by Department One and shall be available to all parties, attorneys and the general public.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all general orders issued and filed in said General Order File shall apply to the entire Los Angeles Asbestos Litigation. The Court will impose appropriate sanctions for any failure by a party to comply with said general orders. Said General Order File shall contain only general orders and no other documents shall be filed therein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all motions requesting a general order, i.e., an order which shall apply to the entire Los Angeles Asbestos Litigation, all motions requesting

1 any modification of any general order, all motions requesting any termination of any general
2 order and all responses to said motions shall be filed in said General Order Motion File and
3 in no other file. All motions concerning the adoption, modification or termination of general
4 orders shall be submitted to the Supervising Judge of the Civil Departments prior to filing.
5 No motion will be accepted for filing unless said motion bears a written authorization from
6 the Supervising Judge of the Civil Departments, which shall appear directly beneath the
7 attorney's signature on the notice of motion.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, if the Supervising Judge of the Civil Departments
9 authorizes the filing of a motion to amend any general order, the Court will establish a
10 hearing date and briefing schedule for such motion. Unless otherwise ordered by the
11 Court, the moving party will give a minimum of forty-five (45) days written notice of the
12 hearing on the motion; any opposition to the motion must be filed and served no later than
13 fifteen (15) days prior to hearing on the motion; any reply to the opposition must be filed
14 and served non later than five (5) days prior to the hearing on the motion.
