been introduced, the court finds that:

All of the allegations in said petition are true; that

Said minor immigrated to the United States under the auspices of

8 for the purpose of adoption as an Intercountry adoption, and said
agency placed the child in the home of said petitioners.

file herein, and has executed the requisite consent to the adoption
which is on file herein.

The petitioners have executed the requisite consent and

agreement that the said child shall be adopted and treated in all respects as their own lawful child and the court, being satisfied that the interests and welfare of the minor will be promoted by the adoption proposed, and that the petition should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the petition is granted and said minor child is now the adopted child of petitioners _____ and _____ and shall be in the custody of said petitioners and be regarded and treated in all respects as their lawful child; that they shall sustain toward the child and the child toward them the legal relation of parents and child, and each respectively shall have all of the rights and be subject to all of the duties of natural parent and child; and that the name of said child shall henceforth be (full new name of child).
