

(OR IF THERE IS A COMPANION ABANDONMENT ACTION)

That the court in _____ County in an abandonment proceeding numbered _____ found said child to be a person defined in Section 7820 of the Family Code and that said child was declared and adjudged to be free from the custody and control of (his) (her) parent(s).

The petitioners have executed the requisite consent and agreement that the said child shall be adopted and treated in all respects as their own lawful child and the court, being satisfied that the interests and welfare of the minor will be promoted by the adoption proposed, and that the petition should be granted; now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition is granted and said minor child is now the adopted child of petitioners _____ and _____ and shall be in the custody of said petitioners and be regarded and treated in all respects as their own lawful child; that they shall sustain toward the child and the child toward them the legal relation of parents and child, and each respectively shall have all of the rights and be subject to all of the duties of natural parent and child; and that the name of said child shall henceforth be (insert full new name of child).
