2	Wyeth and Plaintiffs' Executive Committee shall each submit to	May 17, 2004
3	the Court a list of the five Round I Cases that they believe should	
4	be the first ones to be scheduled for trial, together with any	
5	proposals they may have as to the order in which those cases	
6	should be tried.	
7	The Court will conduct a hearing to discuss the parties' proposed	May 21, 2004
8	case selections and trial plans. The Court will select five of the	
9	Round I Cases for full trial work-up.	
10	All parties shall serve expert witness designations and shall	June 7, 2004
11	disclose their experts' availability for depositions in the five	
12	selected Round I Cases.	
13	All parties shall serve supplemental/counter expert witness	June 21, 2004
14	designations and advise on those experts' availability for	
15	depositions in the five selected Round I Cases.	
16	All parties shall complete their non-expert discovery in the five	July 1, 2004
17	selected Round I Cases; and plaintiffs shall serve their non-case-	
18	specific exhibit lists and their designations of non-case-specific	
19	deposition testimony in the five selected Round I Cases.	
20	Defendants shall serve their non-case-specific exhibit lists and	July 15, 2004
21	their designations of non-case-specific deposition testimony in the	
22	five selected Round I Cases.	
23	All parties shall complete their expert discovery in the five	July 30, 2004
24	selected Round I Cases.	
25	All parties shall serve case-specific exhibit lists, designate case-	August 6, 2004
26	specific deposition testimony, and serve final trial witness lists in	
27	the five selected Round I Cases.
