

1 Liaison counsel for plaintiffs and Wyeth have now submitted a revised pretrial schedule,
2 which the Court finds to be reasonable. Therefore, it is hereby ordered that the following schedule
3 shall apply to the fifteen randomly selected cases (hereinafter, "Round I Cases"):

5 Fact Discovery

6 Wyeth and Plaintiffs' Executive Committee shall each submit to
7 the Court a list of the five Round I Cases that they believe should
8 be the first ones to be scheduled for trial, together with any
9 proposals they may have as to the order in which those cases
10 should be tried.

Monday, June 14, 2004

11 The Court will conduct a hearing to discuss the parties' proposed
12 case selections and trial plans. The Court will select five of the
13 Round I Cases for full trial work-up.

Monday, June 21, 2004

14 All parties shall serve expert witness designations and shall
15 disclose their experts' availability for depositions in the five
16 selected Round I Cases.

Monday, July 12, 2004

17 All parties shall serve supplemental/counter expert witness
18 designations and advise on those experts' availability for
19 depositions in the five selected Round I Cases.

Monday, July 26, 2004

20 General Status Conference

Wednesday, July 28, 2004

21 All parties shall complete their non-expert discovery in the five
22 selected Round I Cases; and plaintiffs shall serve their non-case-
23 specific exhibit lists and their designations of non-case-specific
24 deposition testimony in the five selected Round I Cases.

Friday, July 30, 2004

25 Defendants shall serve their non-case-specific exhibit lists and
26 their designations of non-case-specific deposition testimony in the
27 five selected Round I Cases.

Friday, August 13, 2004

28 All parties shall complete their expert discovery in the five
selected Round I Cases.

Friday, August 30, 2004

specific deposition testimony, and serve final trial witness lists in
the five selected Round I Cases.
